Nailsworth Garden Group Spring Show Schedule of Classes

Class 1 Daffodils Long Trumpet (3 blooms)

Distinguishing characters; 1 flower per stem, trumpet as long or longer than the length of the petals.

Class 2 Daffodils Short trumpet (3 blooms)

Distinguishing characters; 1 flower per stem, trumpet not more than one-third the length of the petals.

Class 3 Daffodils Cyclamineus (3 blooms)

Distinguishing characters; 1 flower per stem, petals significantly reflexed (swept back), flower at an acute angle to the stem, a very short neck.

Class 4 Daffodil Single Bloom

One bloom from any class of daffodil.

Class 5 Daffodils Jonquilla

Distinguishing characters; 1-5 flowers per stem, petals spreading or reflexed, trumpet can be funnel-shaped, cup-shaped, or flared, flowers are usually fragrant.

All the above should be cut with long stems of equal length & displayed in vases.

Class 6 Hellbores (5 blooms of the same or different varieties)

Flowers should be cut with no stem & floated on water in a shallow bowl or saucer.

Class 7 Bits & Pieces from the Garden

This class is an opportunity to display flowers & foliage currently in your garden. Points are given for the number & condition of different varieties of flora in your exhibit. Displays can be shown in any suitable container. Extra points are not awarded for formal arrangements.

Class 8 Foliage from the garden

Points are given for the aesthetic combination of 2 or more varieties of foliage. No flowers are awarded points in this class. Exhibits can be displayed in any suitable container. Extra points are not awarded for formal arrangements.

Class 9 House Plant

Any house plant either flowering or non-flowering.
