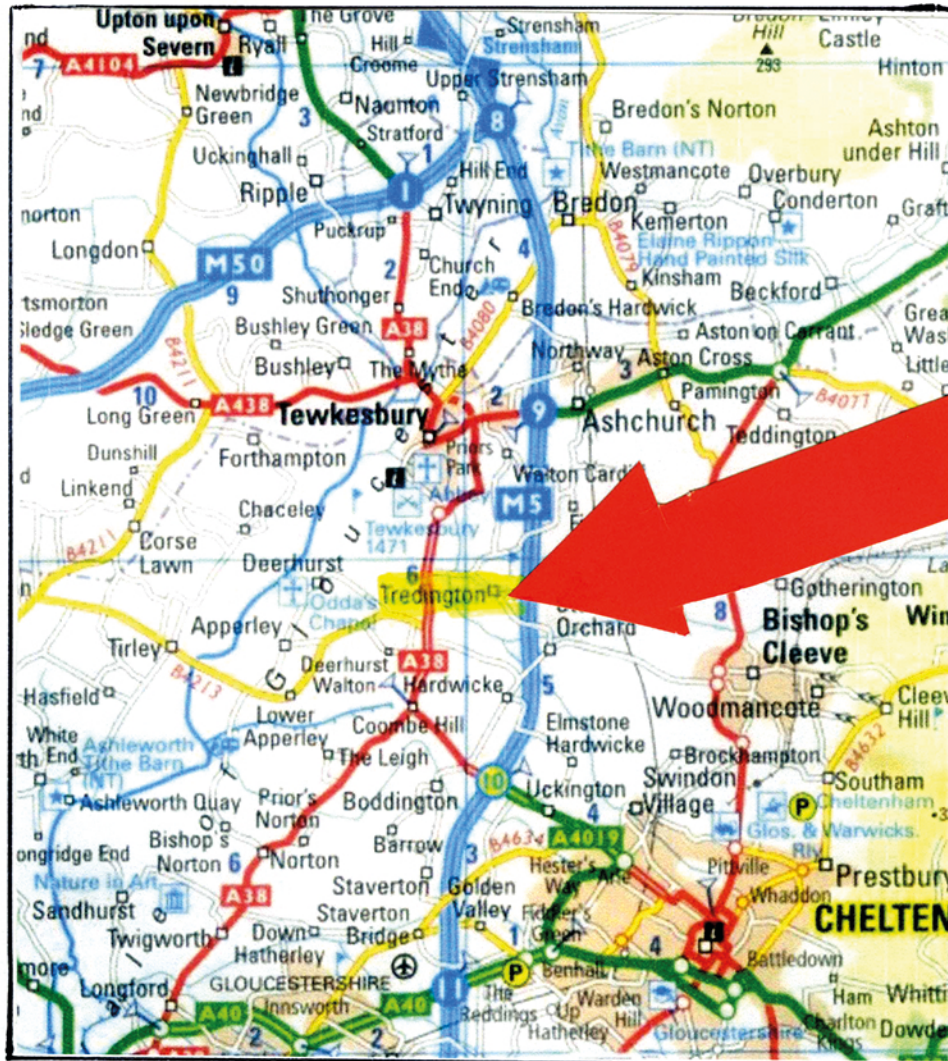

THE STORY OF TREDINGTON RISE



1969: The construction of the M5 motorway worked its way south from the Midlands into Gloucestershire. Archaeologists following the diggers discovered a stone-lined well at Tredington Rise which was identified as the site of a Roman farmstead.

2007: Metal detectorists obtained permission to work on the site and over several years found enough evidence to re-write the history of this area.
