The Cotswold Sculpture Park is in a large area of attractive gardens and woodland in Somerford Keynes near Cirencester. Each year they show a huge number of sculptures made from all sorts of materials and subjects both figurative and abstract, something for all tastes! In amongst these are also some permanent works. There are also a few sculptures and reliefs in a small indoor area next to the café, which has some indoor but mainly outdoor seating, some of which is covered. (Last year they had excellent home-made rock buns!) You need to allow up to 2 hours to get all the way round.

**Booking ahead is not necessary**, or even possible. Payment is by card only on arrival and the cost is £9. This visit will be weather dependent: if it's a rainy day we won't go and you won't pay! I would then look at rearranging for a later date.

**Travel will be by car with car** sharing and I will co-ordinate this. It takes about 30 mins to get there and we aim to meet at 2pm by the café, then explore at our own pace before meeting up for tea and cake (if you wish) at about 3.30-4pm.
