I have arranged for a small group to visit The Woodyard (near Tetbury), home of Wholewoods, to find out how traditional woodcraft skills are being revived and used to produce not just small household items, but also structures and buildings.



Adrian Leaman is a woodman who has been working using traditional skills for over twenty years. Wooden roundhouses and roundwood timber projects are his speciality, both open and enclosed, but he also builds barns and other structures. Adrian runs courses here and teaches elsewhere, ensuring these valuable skills are passed on. The Woodyard is also used by a few others to make small items.

Hawkwood College Roundhouse

This is an opportunity to find out more about how wood can still be used today. This traditional material is an eco-friendly and renewable alternative to the industrial materials we have come to depend upon.
