Sezíncote and Bourton House Garden Visít



Sezincote is a fascinating 200 year old house, designed like an Indian Mogul palace with an adjoining orangerie. The beautiful gardens include a water garden where you can see a number of rare plants. Humphrey Repton was involved in the original planning of the gardens.

Bourton House Garden enjoys wide herbaceous borders, terraces, a Shade House, a White Garden, a topiary walk and water features. There is also a field with specimen trees planted in the 1990s.
