Brockworth Court has a long history going back to the 12th century, while the oldest piece of wall dates to the 13th century. It became a medieval manor house and was later extended. It's a lovely building with a fascinating history including links to Henry VIII and the Guise family. There is also a beautiful tithe barn, faithfully restored after a fire burned down the original in 1996, where we shall be having tea.

This will be a car sharing trip. It takes about 35 minutes and we shall arrive in time to start the house tour at 2pm. This will be followed by time to enjoy the gardens, and then tea with cake, all highly recommended by the Gardening Group who visited last year.
